What the organization can do for you	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> OCYA is an independent office of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, mandated to work with vulnerable young people. The OCYA provides individual and systemic advocacy for children and youth receiving “designated services” as defined under the <i>Child and Youth Advocate Act</i>. This includes young people receiving or attempting to access services under the <i>Child, Youth and Family Enhancement</i> 												

	<p><i>Act and the Protection of Sexually Exploited Children Act</i>; or who are involved with the youth justice system.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The OCYA also provides access to legal representation for young people receiving child intervention services, offers public education, and conduct investigations in serious injuries and deaths of young people receiving designated services
